HOW TO APPLY?

1. Register online, enter your personal data and information about your education.
2. Enter your results of the high school or university diploma (translated into Polish by a sworn translator).
3. Pay the admission fee.
4. Check the list of people qualified to our university (the ranking list is based on the results of the high school/university diploma).
5. Submit the required documents: upload scans online and deliver the original documents or their notarial copies by post to the Recruitment Office of the University of Zielona Góra.

POLISH LANGUAGE COURSE AND STUDIES IN POLISH

Would you like to speak Polish? We will teach you during our Polish language course for foreigners. Thanks to our lessons, you will acquire knowledge allowing to pass a state exam and obtain a certificate. What is more, after completing our course you will be able to study in Polish.

The course is conducted in the following levels:

- elementary level (A1 or A1 – continuation, A2 or A2 – continuation),
- advanced level (B1, B2),
- specialised level (C1, C2).

You can attend both free and paid courses:

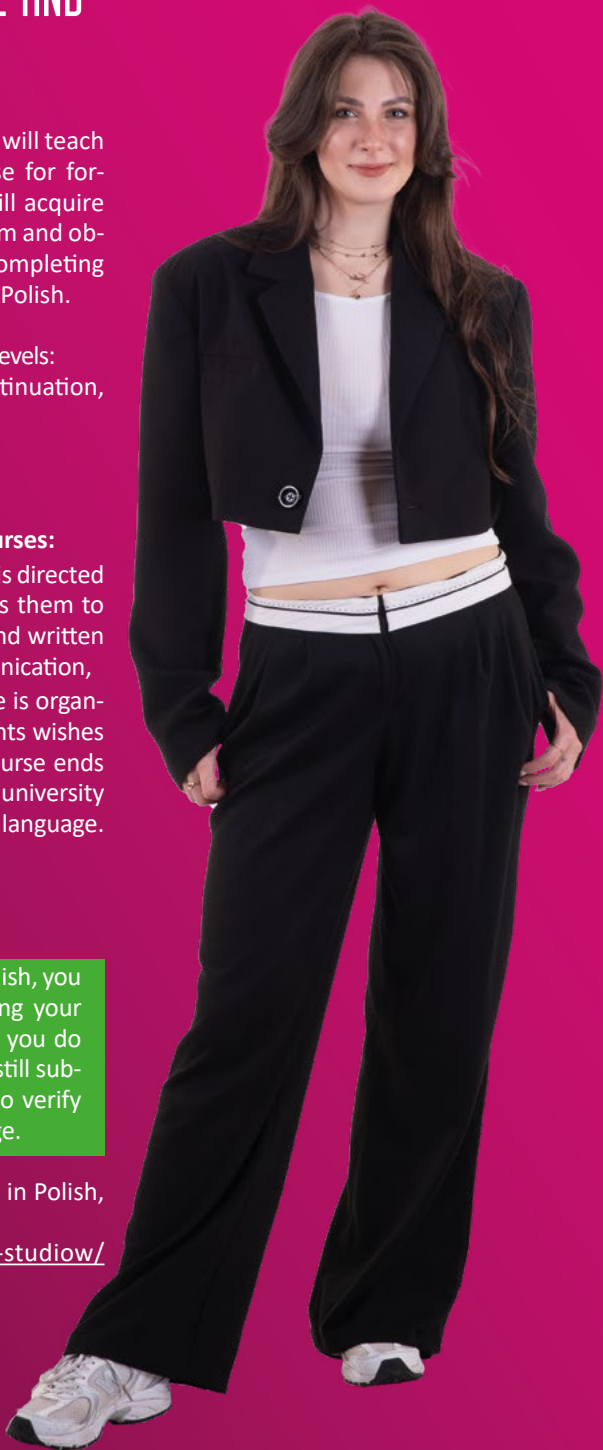
- a free course of the Polish language is directed to all Erasmus+ students and allows them to learn basic phrases of the speech and written language useful in everyday communication,
- a paid course of the Polish language is organised when a group of foreign students wishes to take part in such lessons; this course ends with a certificate conferred by the university or a state exam of Polish as a foreign language.

To undertake studies conducted in Polish, you have to present a document attesting your knowledge of the Polish language. If you do not have such a document, you may still submit an application for an interview to verify your knowledge of the Polish language.

WHAT IS ERASMUS+ ALL ABOUT?

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme that enables university students and employees to undertake long and short-term trips in order to study (for one or two semesters) or do internships in companies and institutions abroad. European students may apply to study at any stage of their studies: bachelor's, engineer's and master's degrees.

All the programmes of study at the University of Zielona Góra are consistent with the principles of the flexible system of education and based on the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Thus, our students can take part in the Erasmus+ programme, which supports EU transparency and recognition tools for skills and qualification.

Erasmus+ allows its participants to travel, make friends with people from various countries, learn about other cultures and traditions, improve their skills in foreign languages, develop professional competences, and establish international cooperation. It's a great experience bringing memories that will last a lifetime!



ERASMUS+ FOR EVERYONE!

The Erasmus+ program aims to promote equal access and social inclusion in terms of:

- disability,
- economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, income, welfare dependent or homeless; young people who have been unemployed or poor for a long time; people in debt or suffering from financial problems,

- cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or their descendants; members of minorities.

In such cases, students are offered additional financial support (provided by the candidate's home university), regardless of the type of studies or internships.



COME TO UZ FOR ERASMUS+!

How to apply for Erasmus+ at UZ? It's very simple!

1. The student's home university needs to send the so-called nomination letter, i.e. information about the student's willingness to study under Erasmus+ at our university.
2. The student has to submit to our Department of International Cooperation the following documents:
 - online Application Form,
 - Learning Agreement for Studies/for Traineeships,
 - photo in an electronic version (.jpg format, max 300kb),
 - bank account details (bank name, address, SWIFT, account number).
